Event Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is Leap for Autism and what do the proceeds support?

A: Leap for Autism is Greystone Programs' community fundraiser event that is open to all. Whether a tandem or virtual skydiver, you can be a Champion for Autism and raise awareness for autism and other developmental disabilities. Your contribution will support Greystone's programs and the individuals we support.

Q: What is peer-to-peer fundraising?

A: Peer-to-peer fundraising allows you to create a personal campaign page and share your fundraising goal with friends, family, and colleagues.

Q: Is there a minimum fundraising requirement to participate?

A: Yes. The minimum is \$500 for tandem skydivers..

Q: What is a tandem skydive?

A: A tandem skydive pairs you securely with a trained professional who guides you through the experience, starting at approximately 13,500 feet.

Q: What are incentives?

A: Incentives are our way of thanking you for exceeding fundraising goals. Please visit the registration page for details.

Q: Are there any deadlines?

A: Yes, minimum fundraising levels must be met by **April 24**. Fundraising may continue beyond this date. If you need a short extension or additional support in reaching your goal, please contact us at development@greystoneprograms.org.

Q: Are there any restrictions to participate?

A: Yes, tandem skydivers must be 18 and older, and there is a weight restriction of 225lbs, more information can be found at www.SkydivetheRanch.com or call the ranch directly with details 845-255-4033 (there may be exceptions depending on your physical conditions.)

Q: What happens if I raise funds, meet my minimum qualifications and cannot attend the day of?

A: Fear not! Arrangements will be made for you to participate at a later date.

Q: How much time should I allocate for my tandem skydive from start to finish?

A: Plan to celebrate the day with us. We encourage you to allow at least four hours for your experience. If you need special scheduling accommodations, please contact us at development@greystoneprograms.org.

Q: Is there an area for my family and friends to watch?

A: Absolutely. Seating is limited, so attendees are encouraged to bring a lawn chair and make themselves comfortable.

Q: Are refreshments served and is there seating?

A: Yes, there will be food trucks, adult beverages, and more for everyone to enjoy.

Q: What happens in the event of inclement weather?

A: The event will be canceled, and participants will be issued a gift voucher for a tandem skydive at Skydive the Ranch.

Q: How will I know if the event is canceled?

A: We will communicate by email and through Greystone Programs' Facebook, Instagram and Twitter pages, and a recorded message will be on our main number (845) 452-5772, the morning of the event.

Q: Is the event Family Friendly?

A: Yes, the event is family-friendly. Trained service animals are welcome. For everyone's safety and comfort, please leave pets and non-service animals at home.
