Club Cool - After School Program

Greystone hosts **Club Cool**, an after-school program for boys and girls ages 6-21 who have been diagnosed on the Autism spectrum and/or other developmental disabilities. The program runs Monday through Friday, from 2:00-6:00 p.m. Children learn self-care, money and time management, safety, and social skills in accordance with their individualized plans.



Weekend Respite and Family Enrichment Nights

Greystone also offers **Weekend Respite**, a program where parents and caregivers can drop their children with disabilities, age 6-21, off once a month. The respite enables caregivers to complete chores or shopping, or enjoy a leisurely afternoon or date with a friend or loved one while their child participates in fun, recreational activities that promote social interaction on-site and on field trips. Respite is usually offered the third Saturday of every month, from 10 am to 6 pm, with reservations made in advance.

Family Enrichment Nights – This program is for families affected by Autism and other developmental disabilities. Families are invited to join us for family supports and child friendship groups. Enjoy a free, casual, family-style meal, followed by discussion, education, networking and support in a comfortable environment. Childcare provided for children with special needs and their siblings. Play activities included. This series runs monthly, Friday evenings, on a varying schedule, from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm.
