Dear Greystone Family Members,

I'm writing to inform you that in accordance with the Office for People with Developmental Disabilities (OPWDD) directive, effective immediately all programs will return to operating at full capacity to the greatest extent possible.

Consistent with CDC guidelines, Department of Health (DOH), OPWDD and local health authorities, the following will be implemented:

- Temperature screening for staff and visitors will continue at all our location.
- All restrictions for visitations and community integration opportunities will no longer apply. Due to continued temperature screening, please call the house prior to your arrival.
- Fully vaccinated staff and individuals will no longer be required to wear masks.
- Unvaccinated staff will be required to wear masks.
- Unvaccinated individuals will be encouraged to wear masks to the best of their ability or if they can tolerate mask wearing.
- There will be no limit for transportation capacity.
- During transportation, all individuals and staff will be required to wear masks.
- Mandating staff who are experiencing any symptoms of illness (i.e., cough, runny nose, headache, fever, body aches) to stay home and self-quarantine for a minimum of 10 days and 72 hours symptom free.
- All high-touch surfaces will continue to be cleaned and disinfected consistent with CDC guidelines.

We will continue to monitor cases throughout the agency and report positive cases to the DOH and OPWDD.

The last 16 months were not easy; however, we persevered together. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. We could not have done this without your support.

We remain committed to the health and well-being of those in our care and Greystone's dedicated support staff. Together, we will emerge victorious.
